


MEN's TIES



Four-in-Hand: This is the move your dad taught you. Five quick motions and you're done. An easy pinch in the middle gives you a centered dimple. And the skinny knot works well with a button-down.









Half Windsor: »

Adding a couple of extra moves widens the knot, which works with most collars. It should be wide enough to fill the center space of your collar.







WindSOF: Named for the Duke of Windsor, perfected by Frank Sinatra, this is the grand-daddy of knots. It takes a little work, yes, but the results will leave others asking how you pulled it off. And with a knot this fat, only a wide, spread collar will do.
